RE: USE OF FORCE ANALYSIS 2020
DATE: January 26, 2021

The following analysis for the 2020 Use of Force Reports is compiled to comply with OCLEAC Standard 1.4.

There were 11 use of force incidents documented for the calendar year 2020. A summary of the criteria is listed as follows: Average age : 32yoa. 3 Black, 1 Hispanic and 7 White suspects. There were 10 male and 1 female suspects.

There were no lethal uses of force, nor was mace utilized in any of the incidents. The electronic control device was utilized in 4 of the 11 incidents, usually as a drive stun in gaining subject control for handcuffing.

No officer injuries were incurred and in 4 incidents minor visible injuries were noted on the suspect, with no suspect requiring hospital treatment. The majority of suspects displayed some level of intoxication or substance use.

Based on the review, there are no specific training, policy, and/ or equipment recommendations.

At least annually, the department should assign a supervisor to prepare an analysis report on use of force incidents. The report should not contain the names of officers, suspects or case numbers, and should include:

- a. The identification of any trends in the use of force by members.**
- b. Training needs recommendations.**
- c. Equipment needs recommendations.**
- d. Policy revision recommendations.**
