RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SAFETY-SERVICE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENTS BETWEEN THE CITY OF LONDON AND THE OHIO PATROLMEN'S BENEVOLENT ASSOCIATION

WHEREAS, the City of London and the Ohio Patrolmen's Benevolent Association have reached agreements for the Patrol and Dispatch bargaining units, which agreement has been reduced to writing and presented to Council for ratification.

The Safety Service Director is hereby authorized to enter into the Collective Bargaining Agreements between the City of London and the Ohio Patrolmen's Benevolent Association's Patrol and Dispatch bargaining units which agreements Council does hereby ratify.

SECTION II:


