**ORDINANCE 187-22**

**AN ORDINANCE FOR STRENGTHS ON JOB DESCRIPTIONS**

**WHEREAS**, the City established the number of employees in each department as required by R.C. § 731.08, commonly referred to as the Strength Ordinance; and

**WHEREAS**, the Strength Ordinance was last adopted in Ordinance 137-22 and the various positions within the City have been modified since it was enacted; and

**WHEREAS**, the City wishes to adopt a new Strength Ordinance.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONDON, STATE OF OHIO**

**SECTION I:**

All departments within the City of London are permitted to hire the following numbers of full-time people to fit each job description per the attached list.

**SECTION II:**

This ordinance specifically excludes strengths on part-time employees, which strength shall depend on the budgeting process.


**SECTION III:**

That this Resolution is hereby declared an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City to take effect and be in full force immediately upon its passage.
