**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE BOARD OF PUBLIC UTILITIES TO
SELL PROPERTY UNNEEDED, OBSOLETE OF UNFIT FOR MUNICIPAL
PURPOSES**

WHEREAS, the Board of Public Utilities (BPU) has certain property that is
unneded, obsolete or unfit for its purposes, namely a 2005 Sterling Acterra trash truck
VIN 2FZACGCS15AN69004; and

WHEREAS, the value of the vehicle is estimated to exceed one thousand dollars
(\$1,000.00); and

WHEREAS pursuant to Ohio Revised Code § 721.15(A), such property must be
sold to the highest and best bidder after advertisement of not less than two (2) nor more
than four (4) consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation in the City of
London.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
LONDON, STATE OF OHIO**

That the BPU is hereby authorized to sell such vehicle in accordance with R.C. §
721.15(A).

SECTION II:


That this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest


