AN ORDINANCE AMENDING 1064 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES

WHEREAS, the City would like to amend the current ordinance to add an additional section; and

WHEREAS, this Council must act to approve the recommendations.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONDON, STATE OF OHIO

SECTION I:

That section 1064.04 shall be amended to read:

1064.04 MAILBOX REPLACEMENT

(1) The City shall repair or replace mailboxes that have been damaged caused by City employees during snow and ice control or any other maintenance activity.

(2) The property owner must submit a written request to the City Administration within twenty-four hours of the incident.

(3) The mailbox will be repaired or replaced by the City with a conventional mailbox. The City shall not replace decorative mailboxes and/or surrounding landscaping.


(4) The City shall not be liable for such replacement when the mailbox is placed outside of the following guidelines: The mailbox position is 41" to 45" from the road surface to the bottom of the mailbox or point of mail entry; mailbox shall be 6" to 8" back from the curb.


That this Resolution shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
