





454.01 DEFINITIONS.

As used in this chapter:

(a) "Bureau" means the Parking Violations Bureau of the City, unless specifically identified as another bureau, in which case it means the bureau so identified.

(b) "Court" or "Municipal Court" means the Madison County Municipal Court, unless specifically identified as another court, in which case it means the court so identified.

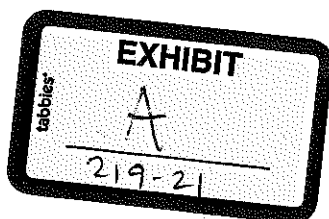
(c) Compact Car means a small, or compact, car as having between 100-109 cubic feet of combined passenger and cargo volume, is in between 161 and 187 inches long.

(ed) "Law enforcement officer" means all officers and positions listed in Section 606.01(h).

(d-e) "Local authority" means every county, municipal corporation, township or other local board or body having authority to adopt police regulations pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State.

(e-f) "Parking infraction" means a violation of any of the provisions of Section 436.09, 438.01, 452.01, 452.03 through 452.12, or 452.14 through 452.16.

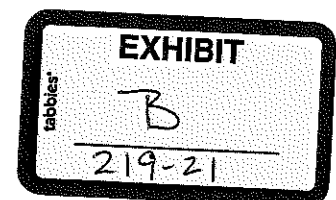
(f-g) "Vehicle" has the same meaning as in Section 402.57.



454.09 PARKING INFRACTION FINES.

The following fines for parking infractions are hereby established:

<u>436.09</u>	Vehicle left upon any street, bridge, causeway or public way when such vehicle displays illegal plates or fails to display the current lawfully required license plates	\$25.00
<u>438.01</u>	Vehicle left upon any street, bridge, causeway or public way when such vehicle has been damaged or wrecked so as to be inoperable or when such vehicle violates the equipment provisions of the Traffic Code whereby its continued operation would constitute a condition hazardous to life, limb or property	25.00
<u>452.01</u>	On streets or highways	25.00
<u>452.03(a)</u>	On a sidewalk, except a bicycle	25.00
<u>452.03(b)</u>	In front of a public or private driveway	25.00
<u>452.03(c)</u>	Within an intersection	25.00
<u>452.03(d)</u>	Within ten feet of a fire hydrant	25.00
<u>452.03(e)</u>	On a crosswalk	25.00
<u>452.03(f)</u>	Within twenty feet of a crosswalk at an intersection	25.00

<u>452.03(1)</u>	Alongside any vehicle stopped or parked at the edge of a curb	25.00
<u>452.03(m)</u>	Upon any bridge, etc.	25.00
